PER CAPITA

Per Capita is crucial to the overall health and well-being of the PC(USA), not only because it provides for our ministries, but because it binds presbyteries, synods, and congregations together in one Church.

The per capita for 2024 is \$40.00 per member, which the church pays to the Presbytery. \$26.95 goes to the Presbytery of Scioto Valley; \$3.25 goes to the Synod of the Covenant; and \$9.80 goes to the General Assembly.
