PER CAPITA

Per Capita is crucial to the overall health and well-being of the PC(USA), not only because it provides for our ministries, but because it binds presbyteries, synods, and congregations together in one Church.

The per capita for 2024 is \$40.00 per member, which the church pays to the Presbytery. \$26.95 goes to the Presbytery of Scioto Valley; \$3.25 goes to the Synod of the Covenant; and \$9.80 goes to the General Assembly.

If you are able to cover your portion, be sure to write on the memo line of your check, or on the envelope that you use, that this offering is for the Per Capita. Thank you for your generosity in helping to cover this cost.
